A special moment of the event was the journey video shown by Mahima, which showcased memories and experiences of the past two years, making everyone emotional.

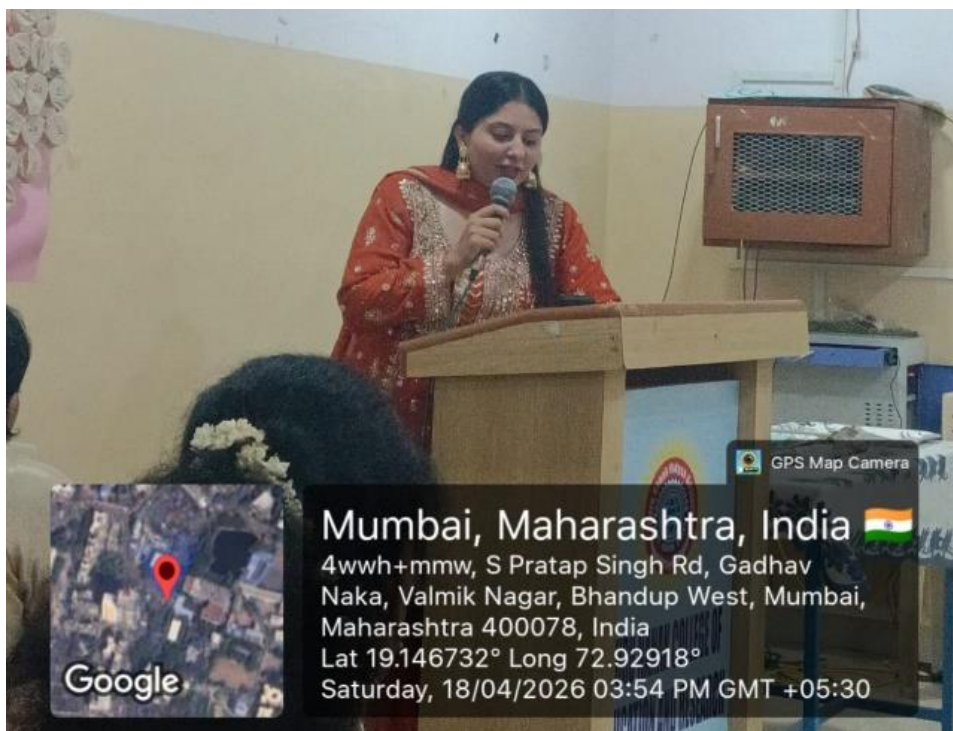
